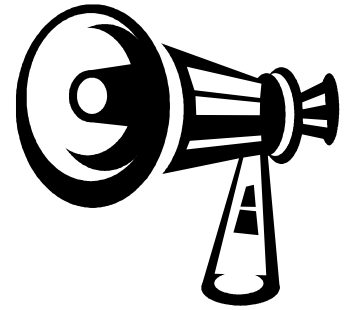

FOOTBALL

- **WHO:** Tryouts include workouts for new and returning athletes for five Jr. Hornets teams: 4th (2nd thru 4th grades), 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th grades.
- **BRING:** Completed registration form on day of Tryouts (3/21). Fill out this form on back or visit www.jrhornetsfootball.com to print a copy. Wear comfortable workout clothing and cleats, and bring water.
- **COST:** Registration fees will be due when equipment is ordered in May. Visit our website's F.A.Q.s link for more cost info.
- **SEASON:** The football season is July through mid-November.

CHEERLEADING

- **WHO:** Spirited individuals who are in 2nd thru 8th grades are invited to try out for a position on the inaugural Jr. Hornets Cheerleading squad.
- Instruction provided by EHS Cheerleader mentors.
- **BRING:** Completed registration on back of this form, also printable from our website at www.jrhornetsfootball.com. Wear comfortable clothing and athletic shoes, and bring water.
- **COST:** Registration fees will be due when uniforms are ordered in May. Visit our website's Cheerleading link for more cost info.
- **SEASON:** Practice will begin in July and end mid-November.

WHY THE JR. HORNETS?

- Players buy/own football/cheerleading gear, enabling returning-athlete savings. Teams are built from Enumclaw residents.
- Teams are formed with a target number of athletes in mind; fewer players = more instruction and playing time. The Jr. Hornets play in a jamboree + 9 regular season games, and participate in cross-county scrimmages as well as post-season playoffs.
- Athletes participate in divisions classified by grade, not weight.
- Jr. Hornets have a mentor partnership with EHS Football/Cheerleading, in which EHS players/cheerleaders practice with and teach our young athletes.
- Jr. Hornets are members of the Greater Puget Sound Youth Football League (www.gpsyfl.org), which has 14 teams from the Plateau and Tacoma area.
